Please submit a detailed resume that includes activities, interests and achievements related to the world of broadcast and production.

Skills Assessment

Each submission requires evidence that demonstrates your potential to build on your skills in the program and place you at a level where you can be successful.

Applicants meeting minimal academic requirements will receive an invitation to participate in a videotaped interview / audition.

This is to ensure that you have a reasonable probability of success in the Radio & Television Arts Diploma program. The interview process will give applicants the opportunity to relate their interest and/or any previous experience and skills to the creative, technical and collaborative nature of the Radio and Television industry.

Other information

Application Review Process

Applications are reviewed as they are received and applicants meeting the criteria of the program prerequisites and entrance portfolio threshold score will be offered a seat in a program section as available. Accordingly, early preparation and submission is recommended. If a seat is not available in the location or program you selected, you may be offered an opportunity to enter a similar program or alternative campus. If your entrance portfolio does not meet the standard, deficiencies will be noted and you will be given the opportunity to address them and re-submit your application as time permits.
