

A.F. THERIAULT AND SON LTD WELDING SPONSORSHIP

This program provides financial assistance to 1 eligible NSCC student in the form of a \$2,000 educational credit and a 5-week work placement with A.F. Theriault and Son Ltd.

About the Sponsor

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

1. Be enrolled **full-time** in the second year of the **Welding - Diploma** program at NSCC's **Burridge Campus** for the **2019-20 academic year**.
2. Be available and willing to complete a 5-week work placement with A.F. Theriault and Son Ltd in Spring 2020.

How We Choose

Recipients of this program will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Application, which includes an essay, resume, and cover letter.
- Demonstration of commitment and interest in program and future career.

Other Information

Depending on the availability of positions, there is potential for full-time employment upon graduation with the sponsor. This is at the sponsor's discretion.

The educational credit will be applied in two installments based on the following:

- \$1,000 will be applied upon selection
- \$1,000 will be awarded upon graduation from the Welding – Diploma program.

Recipients must meet the conditions of the Sponsorship at all points in order to have funds applied to their student accounts and to maintain eligibility. Failure to do so will result in removal from the program and repayment of funds to the Sponsor. The recipients will be asked to sign Return to Service agreements to comply with terms.
