This program provides financial assistance to 1 eligible NSCC student in the form of a \$1,000 educational credit and a 5-week work placement with Architecture49.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

- Be enrolled <u>full-time</u> in the <u>Architectural Engineering Technician</u> program at NSCC's <u>Ivany Campus</u> for the <u>2019-20 academic year</u>.
- 2. Be available and willing to complete a 5-week work placement with Architecture 49 in Spring 2020.
- 3. Preference will be given to applicants who self-identify as Indigenous.

How We Choose

Recipients of this program will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Application, which includes an essay.
- Demonstration of commitment and interest in program and future career.

To Apply

Interested applicants must complete the following to be considered:

• Architecture49 Sponsorship Application

Other Information

The educational credit will be applied in two installments based on the following:

- \$500 will be applied upon selection
- \$500 will be awarded upon completion of work placement.

Recipient must meet the conditions of the Sponsorship at all points in order to have funds applied to their student account and to maintain eligibility. Failure to do so will result in removal from the program and repayment of funds to the Sponsor. The recipient will be asked to sign a Return to Service agreement to comply with terms.
