### Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

1. Be enrolled **full-time** in the first year of one of the following programs for the **2019-20 academic year** at **Marconi Campus**:
  - o IT Programming
  - o IT Systems Management and Security
2. Commit to completing a five-week work placement in Spring 2020 at Debian IT.

## Payment Details

The educational credit will be applied in two installments based on the following:

- \$500 upon selection
- \$500 upon successful completion of placement and graduation from program.

The recipient must meet the conditions of the Debian Information Technology Sponsorship at all points in order to have funds applied to their student account and to maintain eligibility. Failure to do so will result in removal from the program and repayment of funds to Debian IT. The recipient will be asked to sign a Return to Service agreement to comply with terms.
