

EDEN VALLEY POULTRY SPONSORSHIP

This program provides financial assistance for 1 NSCC student in the form of a \$2,000 educational credit, work placement, summer employment, and 1 year of full-time employment with Eden Valley Poultry.

About the Sponsor

Eden Valley Poultry Inc. processes and markets chicken and turkey for Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island farmers. They are a Canadian company that is owned by the producers who supply them with the best quality chickens and turkeys from their family farms.



Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

1. Be enrolled **full-time** in one of the following programs/campuses:
 - o Electrical Technician – Kingstec Campus
 - o Electro Mechanical Technician - Pictou Campus
2. Commit to full-time employment for Summer 2020.
3. Commit to completing a 5-week work placement in Spring 2021.
4. Commit to 1 year full-time employment upon graduation.
5. Maintain an academic average of 75%.

How We Choose

Recipients of this program will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Application, which includes an essay.
- Academic standing.

Payment Details

The educational credit will be applied in two installments: \$1000 in January and the remaining \$1000 to be paid out upon completion of winter term.

The recipient must meet the conditions of the Sponsorship at all points in order to have funds applied to their student account and to maintain eligibility. Failure to do so will result in removal from the program and repayment of funds to the Sponsor. The recipient will be asked to sign a Return to Service agreement to comply with terms.
