Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

1. Be enrolled **full-time** in the **Gas Technician** certificate program at for the **2019-20 academic year** at **Akerley Campus**.
2. Commit to completing a 5-week work experience at Iron Dog.
3. Commit to completing one year of full-time employment at Iron Dog immediately following graduation.
