

## MARITIME BROADCASTING SYSTEM SPONSORSHIP

**This program provides financial assistance for 1-3 NSCC students in the form of a \$1,500 educational credit and a work placement at Maritime Broadcasting System (MBS).**

### About the Sponsor

Maritime Broadcasting System (MBS Radio) is a family owned and operated group of 24 radio stations across Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island. Locally owned and managed, these stations act as hubs in the communities that they serve. ### Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

1. Be enrolled **full-time** in the **second year** of **Radio Television Journalism – Radio Performance & Studio Production Concentration** at **Ivany Campus**.
2. Commit to completing a 5-week work placement at MBS in Spring 2020.

### How We Choose

Recipients of this program will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Application, which includes an essay, resume, and cover letter;
- Academic standing.

## **Payment Details**

The educational credit will be applied to the successful recipients' student accounts in January 2020.

The recipients must meet the conditions of the Sponsorship at all points in order to have funds applied to their student accounts and to maintain eligibility. Failure to do so will result in removal from the program and repayment of funds to the Sponsor. The recipients will be asked to sign Return to Service agreements to comply with terms.
