MICHELIN TECHNICAL SPONSOR A STUDENT PROGRAM

This program provides financial assistance for up to 16 NSCC students in the form of a \$3,000 educational credit and summer co-op work experience at a Michelin facility to eligible students who meet the criteria.

About the Sponsor

Michelin recognizes that real-world experience is key to a well-rounded education. The Michelin Technical Scholarship Program offers hands-on technical training, a financial award, and summer employment to students in select programs who are interested in pursuing a career in manufacturing.



Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

- Be enrolled <u>full-time</u> in the <u>first year</u> one of the following programs for the <u>2019-</u> <u>20 academic year</u>:
 - Electronic Engineering Technician
 - Electronic Engineering Technology
 - Electrical Engineering Technology
 - Electro Mechanical Technician
 - o Industrial Instrumentation
- 2. Attend a 2-hour information and testing session hosted by Michelin Group.
- 3. Be available and willing to work (full-time) at one of the three Nova Scotia plants for Michelin in summer 2020.

How We Choose

Recipients of this program will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Application, which includes a resume and cover letter;
- Score of aptitude testing administered by Michelin;
- Demonstration of commitment and interest in program and future career;
- Interview results conducted by Michelin.

To Apply

There is no standard application for this particular sponsorship program. Interested applicants must complete the following steps to be considered:

- 1. Applicants must attend a 2-hour information/testing session hosted by Michelin Group (dates below).
- 2. Applicants must bring a resume and cover letter to the session indicating their interest in pursuing a career with Michelin Group.
- 3. Selected applicants will be contacted for an interview following the session. The scores of the interview will be combined with the scores of the testing to determine the recipients of the program.

- Conditions for employment must be met and are at the sole discretion of Michelin. Students may also be given priority consideration for any part-time employment at a Michelin plant while studying at NSCC (subject to schedules and locations).

Applicants will be asked to self-disclose within the scholarship application should they wish to be considered for these designated scholarships.
