Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

1. Be enrolled **full-time** in the second year of the Truck and Transport Repair – Diploma at one of the following campuses for the **2018-19 academic year**:
 - Akerley
 - Kingstec
2. Must hold and maintain a high academic average in their program
3. Commit to completing a work placement with Nova Truck Centres and if successful, a minimum of one year of full-time employment at Nova Truck Centres immediately following graduation.

How We Choose

Recipients of this program will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Application, which includes:
 - essay (applicants must speak to why they chose the Truck & Transport Repair route as their career choice)
- Reference (that speaks to the applicant's attitude and aptitude for their career)
- Resume
- Cover letter
- Successful completion of a half-day of job shadowing at Nova Truck Centres.

Payment Details

The educational credit will be applied in two installments based on the following:

- \$1,000 will be applied upon selection
- \$1,000 will be awarded upon successful completion of the work placement and be offered full-time employment with Nova Truck Centres

The recipients must meet the conditions of the Sponsorship at all points in order to have funds applied to their student accounts and to maintain eligibility. Failure to do so will result in removal from the program and repayment of funds to the Sponsor. The recipients will be asked to sign Return to Service agreements to comply with terms.
