2. Must hold and maintain a minimum academic average of 75% in their program.
3. Must have a clean driver's abstract.
4. Must hold a Class 5 license.
5. Commit to completing a work placement with Parts for Trucks Inc. and if successful, commit to summer employment and up to 20 hours per week during

the 2019/2020 academic year.

6. Commit to a minimum of 1 year full-time employment with Parts for Trucks, Inc. upon graduation in Spring 2020.
