

NSCCPost-Care Free Tuition Program

The NSCC Post-Care Free Tuition Program supports individuals who've lived in care in the Nova Scotia child welfare system – including Mi'kmaw Family and Children's Services of Nova Scotia – or have received Youth Services between the ages of 16 – 18 via signed agreement, as defined by Section 19 of the Children and Family Services Act. This bursary covers up to 100% of tuition and fees* for those selected.

Who can apply?

Those who meet the following requirements are encouraged to apply:

- You have lived in care for a minimum of one year (cumulative or accumulated) in the Nova Scotia child welfare system – including Mi'kmaw Family and Children's Services of Nova Scotia and the Nova Scotia Home for Colored Children – or have received Youth Services between the ages of 16 – 18 via signed agreement, as defined by Section 19 of the Children and Family Services Act.
- You are confirmed or are planning to enroll in a program with tuition and associated fees in the upcoming academic year.
- · You have financial need.
- You are pursuing your first post-secondary credential (e.g. certificate, diploma, advanced diploma).
- You are not currently receiving the Nova Scotia Department of Community Services' Educational Bursary Program for Children in Care or the Post-Care and Custody Agreement.
- You are willing to meet with Student Affairs staff to explore other sources of funding and orientation to NSCC.

How to apply

The application for this bursary can be completed in the following steps:

Step 1

We require verification of past child welfare involvement to ensure eligibility for the bursary. Applicants must first seek verification by contacting the Disclosure Program:

Step 2

Visit **nscc.ca/postcare**, fill out the PDF application and submit it, along with the verification letter that you receive from the Disclosure Program, to NSCC's Student Awards Office by emailing awards@nscc.ca or faxing 902-491-2259.

All applications must be received by the posted deadline. Late submissions will not be considered. The number of bursaries available may fluctuate from year to year, depending on funds available.

Selection process

Applications are reviewed by a selection committee. When reviewing applications, the committee will consider the following:

- · Financial need
- Your educational goals, career aspirations and how this bursary can help you attain them
