This program provides financial assistance for up to 30 NSCC students in the form of a \$2000 educational credit, 200 hours of work placement experience, and 1 year of full-time employment at a Shannex facility to eligible students who meet the criteria.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this program, applicants must:

1. Be enrolled **full-time** in the **Continuing Care** program at one of the following NSCC campuses for the **2018-19 academic year** (all Admissions requirements must be completed by the application deadline including a Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check):
 - o Annapolis Valley
 - o Cumberland
 - o Ivany
 - o Kingstec
 - o Lunenburg
 - o Marconi
 - o Pictou
 - o Truro
2. Complete a half day of job shadowing at a Shannex facility as part of the application process;

3. Commit to completing work placements in a Shannex facility (110 hours of skill development + 80 hours of mentorship) and a minimum of 1 year of full time employment with a Shannex facility.

How We Choose

Recipients of this program will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- Application, which includes an essay;
- Job shadow results administered by Shannex (to take place between July 6-20, 2018)
- Availability of job placements/full-time jobs at Shannex facilities.

Work Placement / Job Locations

Recipients are chosen based on region where job opportunities are. The regions below are where the work placement hours and full time employment will take place.

Interested applicants must be willing to travel to the facility locations noted below.

Allocation will be determined by Shannex Incorporated.

2. Half day of job shadowing at a Shannex facility (applicants will be contacted following the application deadline to arrange the job shadow requirement).

Payment Details

The educational credit will be applied in three installments based on the following schedule:

- \$500 will be applied towards fall tuition
- \$500 will be applied towards winter tuition
- \$1000 will be awarded upon successful completion of the program as a signing bonus to Shannex.

Recipients must meet the conditions of the Shannex Pathway to Success Program at all points in order to have funds applied to their student accounts and to maintain Shannex eligibility. Failure to do so will result in removal from Shannex program and repayment of funds to Shannex. Recipients will be asked to sign a Return to Service agreement with Shannex to comply with terms.
