The NSCC Emergency Housing Program provides short-term emergency shelter for students (and their family when needed).

Students can access this program through consultation with their Campus student advisor if they find themselves suddenly without a safe place to live. The program includes support to transition into a longer-term place.

The program was piloted at Institute of Technology Campus, Ivany Campus and Akerley Campus, the aim now is to expand the program province-wide.

The top reason students in the pilot program accessed housing was due to: unforeseen loss of housing and unsafe living conditions.
