<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Download the iCent app for international students Use your student ID number (W#####) to access the iCent app. Use this app to help plan for your move to Canada. You can find the app on Google Play and in the App Store.</p>

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Access your personal NSCC account Use your student ID number (W#####) and temporary password we emailed to the address we have on file for you to login to nsc.ca/mynsc. To protect your security and privacy, we recommended you change your password as soon as possible.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Pay your first-term tuition on or before November 25 Secure your place in your program by making tuition arrangements by November 25. <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Find housing We always recommend that students moving to Nova Scotia plan to arrange for temporary accommodation close to the airport for their first night in Nova Scotia. We also recommend arranging temporary accommodation close to your campus: finding housing can take some time and you'll need a place to stay while you look for a place to live.</p> <p>We ask all international students to download our iCent app to review our travel planning checklists, housing and accommodation information, how to plan your transportation to campus and more. It also provides details/updates on current COVID-19 quarantine planning requirements in effect for Canada, the province of Nova Scotia and NSCC and is updated regularly.</p> <p>Questions? <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Complete your Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) + Workplace Hazardous Materials Information Systems (WHMIS) certificates</p> <p>Getting your certifications in Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) and Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) is mandatory for every student in any program. They must be completed before January 30. Review the details at nsc.ca/safetycourses</p>
