# **Update your DLI when you** change schools

As a post-secondary student, you can change your school, program, field of study or level of study (e.g. from the Bachelor level to the Master's level) without applying for a new study permit, or applying to change the conditions of your permit. You may continue to use your study permit as long as it is valid. **You must update IRCC with the new DLI information if you change schools.** 

If you already have a co-op work permit, you must apply for a new one to show NSCC as your institution—use your letter of acceptance from NSCC in the application.

### To transfer your DLI you need:

- your study permit number
  - $_{\odot}$   $\,$  It begins with the letter "S" and is at the top right of the permit.
  - For security reasons, we may ask you to provide a few details from your application, so have it handy.
- NSCC's designated learning institution (DLI) number
  - You can find it on the list of designated learning institutions.
- your NSCC Student Identification Number (Student ID)
  - You can find it on the acceptance letter for NSCC It starts with a "W".
- The start date of your OLD DLI and also NSCC.
- Your passport
- The DLI number of your previous university or college that is linked to your study permit
- Your acceptance letter for your previous university or college is linked to your study permit. (to help you find the start date of your previous school)

- 1. Sign in to your GCKey account
- 2. Click **"Transfer from DLI number"** under the section Designated Learning Institution Student Transfer.

*"Application Details"* - it is recommended you use Application Number and UCI number as they are both on your study permit.

"Applicant's Personal Information" - it is recommended you use your Passport information

*"Information about the applicant's study in Canada"* - it is recommended you use the DLI number of YOUR OLD DLI (e.g. if you are transferring from SMU, then you would use your SMU DLI number) and your previous school's start date. This is the start date for your old DLI (that you provided for your original study permit application.

- 5. Enter your new DLI number (NSCC's DLI number), your new Student ID number (your "W" number), and your start date of your NSCC program. Click **"Submit transfer"**.
  - Remember the first digit in your DLI is a capital letter "O", not a zero "O"
