We have begun creating a series of short, just-in-time videos to support student learning in the moment of need. Students can find videos related to using library resources, Academic Integrity, and APA Citation on our YouTube Channel. This collection will continue to grow as staff develop videos on additional topics.

Laptop Loan Program

NSCC Libraries has over 600 laptops available for loan. Students who require a laptop can borrow one from the library for a term, completely free of charge. Our laptops were loaned over 1,200 times this year, indicating that they were in-use year-round by students who required technology supports.

Classroom Learning

Libraries are a key support to faculty when it comes to meeting the outcomes for many courses. Over 4,900 students participated in classroom sessions facilitated by NSCC Librarians. Topics of these sessions included Academic Integrity, APA Citation, Research Skills, Evaluating Information, Critical Thinking Skills, and more.
