


## YES! You can use copyright protected works to create NEW works.

Non-commercial User-generated Content (section 29.21) AKA "The YouTube Provision"



You have the right to create new content from copyright protected works, including the right to share and post your new work (Yes... this means you can post to YouTube) as long as you meet **4** conditions:

- **1.** Non-commercial: You are not going to sell your new work or use the video to promote/sell products.
- 2. No adverse effect on the original: Your new work doesn't replace the original work or compete with it sales/business of the original content is not affected.
- 3. Work(s) used are publicly available and
- **4.** Include credit (if it is reasonable to do so) for the works you copied and used in your new work. For example, include a credit slide.

**Creating a video?** It is reasonable to expect credits will be included. Include a credit section at the end and give credit for the copied content you used.

## IMAGES

Images with a **CCO license** or images in the public domain do NOT require a credit. They are free to use without attribution unless including credit is a requirement of your assignment and is required by your instructor. CCO images are an excellent option for brochures and posters.

Photos in the repository have the most open **Creative Commons license -- CCO.** CCO licensed content is free to use and requires NO attribution.

• <u>Pexels</u> Fee high quality photos. Photos in the repository have

the most open Creative Commons license -- CCO.

- <u>Unsplash</u>
  - Free photographs.

Attribution is not required but is appreciated.
